We pray for greater protection of human rights and a decrease in political corruption; for those families torn apart by the separation of North and South Korea; for those in North Korea who suffer from malnutrition and starvation; for a just and peaceful resolution to all political disputes, especially tensions between China & Taiwan, and Japan & South Korea; for those who seek power, prestige and wealth at the expense of spiritual wholeness, that they may be filled and renewed; for indigenous peoples in Taiwan; for those still rebuilding their lives after powerful earthquakes and nuclear devastation; and for children forced into prostitution.
