As part of the **ecumenical prayer cycle**, we ask you to pray for a particular region of the world each week. This week we pray for Sudan, South Sudan and Uganda. We give thanks for those working to make peace agreements benefit the Sudanese people; for those refugees able to return home; for those taking care of refugees, and for international aid organizations; for peace-makers working to find solutions to Sudan's divisions; for those who strive to end the civil war in Uganda; and for the commitment of the Ugandan government to control the AIDS epidemic. We pray for an end to the bombing of innocent civilians by the Sudanese government; for a just solution to the conflicts between the Sudan and South Sudan; for those divided by civil wars and violence between ethnic and religious groups; for refugees in and near Darfur; for groups such as the Bantu, Melut and Adariyal who have been displaced from their villages due to the oil research in their areas; for an end to corruption in public offices, so that governments can better serve their people and public funds benefit the many

and not just the few; for those suffering from HIV and AIDS, particularly children who have been orphaned by the disease; for Uganda and its neighbors achieving an open partnership for lasting peace and an end to the violence perpetrated by the LRA.
