#### From the Pastor's Desk

Joy to the World, the Lord is come." -Isaac Watts

Dear Friends,

December 1 was the first day of Advent, and we had a wonderful worship.

We are using the theme of "Heaven and Nature Sing" from the beloved hymn "Joy to the World." This year marks the 300<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the song and is a beautiful theme for our time together.

Composer Isaac Watts' interpretation of Psalm 98 invites us to sing a "new song"—and it is a powerful performance of all creation being renewed and freed. Rather than "joy" being yet another word for "happiness," we will discover that the depths of joy can be found especially in the midst of suffering, the work of justice, and the presence of compassion—all part of the coming of Jesus to this world and a message the world still so desperately needs.

The following is a translation of Psalm 98:4-6 by Nan C. Merrill:

"Make a joyful noise to the Beloved all the earth;
break forth into grateful song and sing praises!
Yes, sing songs of praise extolling
Love's way;
lift up your hearts with gratitude and joy!"

Happiness is fleeting, reliant upon outward circumstances. A beautiful day, a good cup of coffee or our team winning the game can all bring us happiness. Joy, however, is constant, an understanding that in all things, God will prevail. We can have joy in the midst of our sorrow or heartbreak. In fact, these are the times that we often feel even closer to God.

I hope you will join us in worship as we joyfully sing God's praises and declare the wonder of God's love for us!
