From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Friends,

I want to tell you about a new thing happening for me and for our presbytery.

At a meeting on January 24, the Indian Nations Presbytery voted to have me as their Stated Clerk. The Stated Clerk is the official record-keeper of the presbytery (our regional body in the U.S). Duties include such things as recording minutes from meetings, working with other presbyteries to transfer pastors, keeping up-to-date records of churches, pastors and others, as well as more stuff that I will be learning about! Our presbytery continues in a time of transition as we function without a General Presbyter, so the position carries additional responsibilities at this time.

This will be a 16-20 hour per week position. It will take me out of the office a day or two during the week and the rest I can do in Norman. I will be leaving my other job as hospital chaplain, though there will be some time that I will have all three jobs as I transition out of the hospital work.

I am excited about this new venture. I enjoy learning new things, interacting in a new setting, and connecting with colleagues in the greater church. I have always appreciated service to the denomination and am grateful for this new opportunity.

What does this mean for Memorial? While I can't say with 100% certainty, I don't believe there will be much noticeable change. I will be out of the office some on a regular basis, but I will always be available (as I have been) by phone, text or email. My schedule at the presbytery is largely adaptable, and I will be able to adjust as needed.

I am so grateful for the support I have received from the Session, the personnel committee and from others who have heard about this new opportunity. I look forward to this new challenge to which God is calling me.

## WORSHIP AND MUSIC

Have you noticed that each Sunday the bulletin indicates which Sunday it is on the church calendar? January 20 was the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday after Epiphany or the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time, January 27 was the 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday after Epiphany or the 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time, etc. (Epiphany was January 6<sup>th</sup>. The first Sunday after Epiphany was the Baptism of the Lord, falling this year on January 13). This is how the Christian calendar marks the time leading to the Transfiguration of the Lord (March 3), Ash Wednesday (March 6) and Lent.

Joan Cole is taking the lead in planning a special service for Ash Wednesday. Vince Leseney and Solena Rizzato are leading plans for the services for Lent, Palm Sunday, Holy Week and Easter.


