The windows around us

As most of you know, the east window in the sanctuary has been leaking for some time. Building and Grounds is targeting this summer to get that taken care of. To fix the problem the entire window will need to be removed and reconstructed, much like was done with the north and west windows several years ago. Obviously, this will not be cheap. Removal, reconstruction and re-installation of the window will be about \$25,000.00. As is always the case with a project like this, there is the possibility of unexpected expenses, so our goal is to have \$30,000.00 available.
