Dear Friends,

As I write you today, we are one day from a presbytery meeting. This one is our biennial Tri-Presbytery meeting, when all three Oklahoma presbyteries meet together. It looks to be a good gathering as we meet in Oklahoma City at Westminster Presbyterian Church!

As the new Stated Clerk of our presbytery, I am learning that it takes a great deal of behind the scenes work to make the two days happen. We started discussing this meeting last fall. Meetings, emails, and phone calls all help get the event put together. Coordinating visitors and guests, as well as our own members, meals for those attending, A/V needs, getting directions and hotels to them all make for a great deal of work for all three presbytery offices.

Then we have to put the meeting together. There are agendas and minutes, finding out who needs to speak and make presentations, and putting them all together means trying to make a seamless meeting. It was coming along relatively well.

And then....AND THEN...our computer server at the presbytery office was hacked. Ransomware appeared and it took some 10 days to be fully up and running again. It was frustrating, to be sure. But I realized that though we had some roadblocks in our way, it wasn't life and death. This "event" coincided with the storms the state (and country) have been having, and really puts into place what is important.
