#### From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Friends,

How do you refuel? Or prepare for a coming event?

Many of you know I was able to participate in a clergy retreat last week. It was a great time to get away from my regular routine, connect to colleagues (and even meet a few new ones) and to hear from an engaging leader who challenged and comforted us.

Some vacations are restful; others are adventurous. A vacation can be a time to refuel as well. Though some vacations end up being a lot of effort and work, even those can be regenerative. Maybe its flexing some "muscles" that are rarely used. Maybe it's looking at the world in a new way. Perhaps it is connecting to friends or family in a different way.

I am a big fan of changing up a routine, not just for change's sake, but to use the opportunity to look at things in a different light.

We have an opportunity to look at Advent in a different way this year. That's right, I'm already talking about Advent! 
